All SOA! Event Report Forms along with donations & mini grant forms can be sent to the AOII Foundation at the AOII Hedquarters address 5390 Virginia Way, Brentwood TN, 37027. The SOA! Event Report Form is available on Fulfilling the Promise under Philanthropy (2nd page in this document).

Collegiate Chapter SOA! event recognition is a part of our Excellence in Philanthropy Award for collegiate chapters that is presented annually at International Convention/Leadership Institute. Submitting an SOA! Event Report Form is mandatory for any chapter wishing to qualify in this category.

All money raised at the SOA! event should be mailed along with the Event Report Form within 30 days of the event date. Please have all funds turned in by **April 15**. For any events after April 16 to the end of International Convention/Leadership Institute, please fill out the Philanthropy/Fundraising Event: Pre-Event Form found on Alphalink prior to April 15 and provide the estimated amount raised during the event. This is to give credit to all chapters who held an event during the year prior to International Convention/Leadership Institute. All chapters who submit money prior to April 15 (excluding the cases where the event is after April 15) will receive recognition at International Convention/Leadership Institute.
