### 2019 Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI) Scholarship

The Alpha Omicron Pi Foundation is pleased to provide a full scholarship for one woman from any AOII chapter to attend the **2019 Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute (UIFI)** with preference given to chapters in the Northeast US and Canada. This institute is seen as the premier leadership academy for fraternity and sorority members. UIFI sessions will be offered in the summer of 2019 in Bloomington, Indiana. The institute features experiential learning and hands-on activities, an opportunity to meet fellow Greeks from all 50 states and Canada, and curriculum that teaches you how to lead with passion and integrity.

#### What is the scholarship?

One scholarship of \$550 is available, which will cover the full registration cost of UIFI. The registration fee includes all workshop materials, meals, lodging during the session dates, social activities and transportation to and from the Indianapolis airport. Once the scholarship is awarded, the student must apply directly with UIFI and indicate she is receiving a scholarship. After the event, NIC will bill the AOII Foundation for the registration fee. **Students will be responsible for their own transportation.** Students should NOT make travel arrangements without confirmation of acceptance by NIC.

#### Instructions:

**Step One:** Applicant completes the application below and requests a copy of her transcript from her university be sent to the AOII Foundation.

**Step Two:** Applicant sends the completed application along with her transcript no later than **March 30, 2019**, to [scholarships@alphaomicronpi.org](mailto:scholarships@alphaomicronpi.org).

**Step Three:** The AOII Foundation will select the most qualified candidate to receive the award. Recipient will be notified of the scholarship in early April, at which time she will apply to attend the UIFI session of her choice, before the early registration deadline of April 23, 2019. Once acceptance has been received from UIFI, she can make travel arrangements. *The scholarship will not cover transportation expenses.*
