As a follow-up to our initial communication released March 11, we would like to emphasize that AOII owned and managed facilities across the U.S. and Canada will remain open to provide accommodations to our membership.

Should this change at a local level due to University regulations, we will discuss this with the chapters on an individual basis. In some cases, this has occurred, and we will continue to monitor this across the country.

Please see below for AOII's recommendations regarding social distancing:

- Be sure to not gather as a group of 10 or more in a small space.
- Consider eating a seat or two apart during this time; the CDC is recommending a safe distance of six feet.
- Be considerate of others in the space, and make sure you are taking necessary hygiene precautions.
- Maintain communication with chapter leadership and House Director (if applicable) on your plans for staying at or leaving the facility.

If you have a communal living space, your chapter needs to ensure they are able to accommodate the above recommendations. If you have any questions or concerns about how to do this, please reach out to an AOII Properties staff member.

We are taking precautions from an international level with our on-staff Property Management team to address cleanliness concerns with the local cleaning employee(s) to confirm they are taking the appropriate measures.

If your university has chosen to close for an extended Spring Break and/or has closed indefinitely, we ask that only residents with a signed in-house agreement be in the facility during this disclosed time. Even after this time, we ask you not to allow out-of-house AOII members or guests into the facility, in line with national guidelines. Currently, we are still permitting vendors and necessary inspections to occur for both the safety of our members and the long-term maintenance of the property.

Please continue to follow both government protocols and CDC recommendations regarding next steps should you feel ill. If you feel the need to self-isolate or quarantine, communicate this immediately to the House Director, local chapter leadership, or AOII Properties and we will discuss the next steps to handle this appropriately. If you or any in-house chapter members have recently traveled outside of the country for Spring Break, a study abroad trip, or anything of the like, please communicate that immediately. In the inventory list we sent to chapter's House Directors or chapter leadership, we asked that that be specified. Per our original communication, if your University has released guidelines - follow those. Otherwise, if you have traveled to what is considered a "level 3" country, you will need to self-quarantine and are not able to return to the facility at this time.

This is a developing situation and can change at any time. We will continue to provide updates as we have them.

Please note: At this time, our only priority is ensuring our members have a healthy and safe place to reside.
