Recruitment Ambassador Position Description

Overview of the Recruitment Ambassador Program

The maintenance and development of our Fraternity is entrusted to our collegiate members. Our Ritual reminds us how important it is to be thoughtful and considerate when we are choosing who is to hold membership in Alpha Omicron Pi. With this in mind, the Fraternity launched a program to provide recruitment specific training and support to our collegiate chapter members.

Recruitment Ambassadors are selected, trained, and deployed to provide recruitment training to our collegiate chapters. The purpose of the Recruitment Ambassador program is to facilitate the <u>Fraternity's Recruitment Curriculum</u>, which focuses on: branding, the Fraternity's International Membership Selection Program (IMSP), cultivating relationships, social excellence, and valuesbased conversations. Ambassadors are selected for their distinct ability to elevate the material with their own stories and experiences.

Who is eligible to be a Recruitment Ambassador?

Alumnae members of Alpha Omicron Pi who have a willingness to learn, prior facilitation experience and a passion for advancing the interests of the Fraternity are eligible and encouraged to apply. Applicable experience in recruiting, human resources, marketing, education or training is also desired.

What is the role of a Recruitment Ambassador?

The primary role of the ambassador is to conduct workshops for AOII collegiate chapters. Each ambassador will facilitate 4-6 workshops over the course of the academic year. Recruitment Ambassador appointments are for one year, with the option to reapply. This is not a Council position.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Presenting the Fraternity's Recruitment Curriculum modules
- Modeling strong communication
- Clarifying, summarizing, and sharing ideas
- Guiding group discussions
- Challenging thinking and encouraging reflection

How will Ambassadors be trained for this role?

A required weekend training workshop will be conducted at AOII International Headquarters the weekend of July 31-August 3, 2020. Travel reimbursements, lodging and meal expenses and necessary materials associated with the training are provided. Please do not make travel arrangements until after you have received confirmation of your placement and initial instructions.
