# GUIDELINES WITHIN THE ALPHA OMICRON PI FACILITY

For the health and safety of our members we have implemented the following:

Masks are to be worn at ALL times when in the Alpha Omicron Pi Facility common areas.

*NOTE: exceptions will be made when eating/drinking & social distancing can be achieved.*

A cleaning service has been hired and will be cleaning the facility/areas of high volume regularly.



Where possible, we are working towards creating additional seating options & study areas both indoors and outside.



*Cleaning supplies such as Clorox wipes will be readily available for use, along with thermometers upon request.*

# MEALS & DINING



*NOTE: This information is **NOT OFFICIAL**, these scenarios are still pending University approval/guidance. Updates will be sent out as they are updated.*

## Scenario A:

Hot and cold lines will be operational with food service staff handling service. Plexiglass dividers will be installed to ensure members do not have the ability to reach food.

## Scenario B:

If this is not plausible at your chapter's house, food service staff will prepare your food and hand it to you. Meals will be served on a pre-boxed/to-go.

*Both options will include flexible meal times to allow for social distancing. To reiterate, neither scenario has been finalized and we may see a hybrid version of both. As a reminder, masks are required in the dining rooms until you have taken a seat with your food. Please be mindful of the table/chair placement due to social distancing, too.*

## Snacks:

- Individually wrapped/prepared items
- Items placed so that they can be individually picked up without touching other items

# LIVING IN-FACILITY



## Areas where masks will be required:

*NOTE: Anywhere in which a minimum of six feet cannot be achieved.*

- Study rooms
- All living areas
- Elevators
- Stairways
- Laundry rooms

## Areas where masks will NOT be required:

*NOTE: Although not enforced in these specific areas, we encourage you to utilize a mask as much as possible*

- Residential areas
- Once sat with food in the dining room
- Showers

## Policy on Guests:

Members that do **not** live-in will **NOT** be permitted upstairs under any circumstances. This includes work week/recruitment.

As of now, gatherings of any sort will **NOT** be allowed until further notice.

## Move-In & Living Experience:

Alpha Omicron Pi has implemented an Acknowledgement of Personal Responsibilities & Expectations that all in-house members must sign before moving in. Refer to the Move-In Guide for more Information.

We are continuously developing new and creative ways to make your 'in-house living' experience safe and enjoyable.

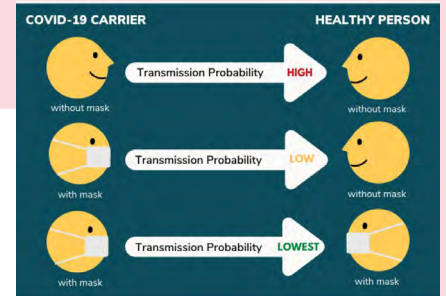
# WHY IS THIS INFORMATION IMPORTANT?

## Why Wear a Mask?

*Even though you personally may not be at high risk for COVID 19, others around you can be!*

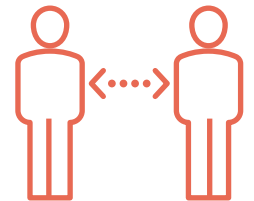
Coronavirus can be spread through coughing, sneezing, or speaking at close range, even BEFORE symptoms appear.

The importance of using face coverings is best illustrated in the graphic.



## Why Practice Social Distancing?

COVID-19 spreads mainly among people who are in close contact (within about 6 feet) for a prolonged period, putting distance between yourself and others helps reduce the risk of spreading the virus.



## Why Wash Your Hands?

Alpha Omicron Pi is doing our best to clean surfaces regularly. However, you cannot always control what you touch or who else touched it. Hand-washing with soap and warm water for 20 seconds (equivalent to singing the ABC's 2x through) is the most powerful weapon against Coronavirus and killing germs.
