On December 23, 1896, four remarkable women from Barnard College—Stella George Stern Perry, Jessie Wallace Hughan, Elizabeth Heywood Wyman, and Helen St. Clair Mullan—came together to establish Alpha Omicron Pi. United by their profound friendship and shared values, they created AOII, a bond that has blossomed into an enduring sisterhood. Just days after making their pledge in the library, AOII was officially founded at Helen's residence on January 2, 1897, now celebrated as Founders' Day.



HOUSING OBLIGATION

If her chapter has a housing facility, she may have the opportunity to live there when space is available. Members are responsible for filling open spaces in chapter facilities.

Your AOII member will be expected to meet financial obligations promptly. Dues are collected through BillHighway, and fees may vary depending on her college or university, as well as membership status, whether she's a new member or has been initiated.

GET TO KNOW THE foundation


The Alpha Omicron Pi Foundation is a 501(c)3 nonprofit that enhances the sisterhood of AOII through investment in our sisters, and inspires a lifetime of giving to innovative leadership, educational, and philanthropic causes. The AOII Foundation was established in 1977, and since its inception, the Foundation has contributed over \$7 million to philanthropic causes, scholarships and grants that help our sisters grow in their careers and lives.

> The Ruby Fund assists AOII members who are facing serious health issues, unforeseen financial conditions, natural disasters, and other forms of crises. Since 1946, AOII's Ruby Fund has assisted more than 390 sisters in need.


Depending on the structure for the chapter on your daughter's campus, she may get the opportunity to live in the chapter facility.
